While we gained some financial momentum through the spring, we have hit the summer doldrums and giving has declined rapidly in June. An ongoing deficit in the weekly offering for the General Fund is unsustainable, particularly when some prior weekly deficits in the Mortgage Fund were offset by mild surpluses in the General Fund. Accordingly, please plan ahead to maintain regular giving through the Summer to help avoid negatively impacting our ministries and operations. We will continue to monitor this situation closely, and ask for your prayers for generosity at Resurrection.

Notes: As designated by the asterisk (*), the Weekly Offering Needed for both the General Fund and the Mortgage Fund includes an additional \$250.00 per week so we can begin rebuilding our respective Funds to ensure we have at least one month's reserves in those Funds at all times. We also note that the amounts reported under the Weekly Offering Needed in the General Fund reflect the reinstated full rate of pay for employees.

How Is Our Garden Growing?

The rains came and the plants grew! The Community Garden is fully rented and the plots are turning green with healthy looking produce. Our gardeners are having fun stopping by RLC and watching change happen day by day.

Here are some interesting Community Garden facts:

- The ages of this year's gardeners span 80 years
- 11 plots are rented by folks who don't attend RLC
- One plot is being used to grow food for the Monticello Food Shelf!

The RLC Community Garden Team has put in well over 150 hours of work into creating the garden. The grant sponsors, Live Wright!, have been very impressed and gave our garden an additional \$1500 in labor funding which the team donated back so we can purchase a shed, picnic table and perhaps a rotor-tiller. In total, the garden received \$5,180 in grant funds and everyone involved is very pleased with how smoothly the project has progressed and how positively it has been received. Thanks to the Community Garden team (Engstrands, Ericksons, Erlandsons, Forsbergs, Hayes, Mayos, Sells, Suedbecks) for making this project happen and for having so much fun in the process! Thanks to God for bringing forward the gifts and skills needed, and we pray He will continue to bless our garden with good fruit of every kind.
