- ≈ Strengthening our Student Leadership ministry by offering a number of new and exciting growth opportunities including a winter retreat and possible conference.
- ≈ Coordinating a 6<sup>th</sup> grade Youth Works Mission trip to Minneapolis beginning in the summer of 2010 (in addition to the 2010 high school growth experience)
- ≈ Considering the potential addition of a part time staff person to expand our flourishing Youth and Family Ministry

# Ministry Goals

## Adult Spiritual Growth

Nurturing the Faithwalk of every adult by offering Bible studies, Alpha, seminars, workshops, retreats and social gatherings to further our discipleship process called Pathways to GROW! CONNECT! SERVE!

- ≈ Researching small group ministry models by end of May, 2010, to determine direction for Resurrection
- ≈ Looking for an opportunity to increase the all church small group study and worship series by one additional offering.
- ≈ Maintaining the current number of retreats while increasing the % of attendees by 5%.
- ≈ Promoting the use of the library on a quarterly basis.
- ≈ Adding two new offerings for parents by July, 2010.

## Congregational Care

Promoting wholeness and wellness of the community by compassionately caring for the members and friends of Resurrection.

- ≈ Strengthening our Connections Ministry (formerly known as Membership)
- ≈ Continuing to partner with Worship & Music in providing meaningful Healing Services 3 x/year
- ≈ Encouraging physically and emotionally healthy behaviors as a part of the pathway to wholeness
- ≈ Supporting the spiritual wellness of members and friends through ongoing support of Prayer Ministries

## Children & Family

Equipping and mentoring parents to be the primary spiritual leaders in their home while supporting them in nurturing the faith walk of their children.

- ≈ VBS - Continuing to improve our healthy and vibrant VBS program by changing our leadership team from a Co-Coordinator form of leadership to a team leadership model that will meet monthly from Jan to Sept.
- ≈ Camp Ministry - Expanding our current focus of Bible Camp ministry by creating a one week, in house camp experience for children during the early summer months.
- ≈ Family Ministry - Continuing to develop our family ministry by expanding the use of Faith 5 and equipping families to use this home based tool.

## Community Outreach

Equipping members and friends of Resurrection to reach outward in service and to extend an invitation of welcome to join us as we partner with Christ to change lives through community outreach.

- ≈ Creating a training program emphasizing the importance of inviting and welcoming people into the church family where they can have the opportunity to GROW! CONNECT! SERVE! by April 2010
- ≈ Continuing pathways of partnership with other Monticello organizations to serve those in our community.
- ≈ Maintaining current programs and events to ensure alignment with mission and goals of RLC.
- ≈ Bringing Outreach Ministry opportunities into ALL ministries of Resurrection.

## Generosity

Helping people grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ through their generosity of time, talents, finances, and stories.

- ≈ Increasing number of member/family consistently giving.
- ≈ Evaluating the use of outside company to increase member/family giving.
- ≈ Providing a financial Christian educational opportunity.
- ≈ Providing a paperless option to complete the time & talent survey.

## Operations

Partnering with all ministry areas to provide encouragement, support and equipping systems needed to ensure Resurrection's Pathway support and forward motion of God's vision for GROW! CONNECT! SERVE!

- ≈ Maintaining the Building/Grounds of Resurrection on a daily basis to ensure that all find us hospitable.
